


Course Formats:

Number of sections:


Choose number of required sections. This may be changed in the course as needed.

Course layout: Choose:

- Show one section per page displays one section on the page with navigation buttons; must click on breadcrumb at top of course to return to grid view
- Show all sections on one page displays each section in a separate pop-window with navigation arrows or option to close window to return to grid

Multiple settings available to change color, size, and various other grid box options - default recommended

Navigate by breadcrumb or next/previous arrow or X and close out to return to grid



Grid format Teacher Editing View

Course layout: Regardless of layout choice:

1. Show all sections on one page 2. Show one section per page

Teacher editing view will look like window shown. Red outline delineates course material editing


The course format only affects student view and access



- Custom images maybe added to grid boxes




