

3 options: copy URL code, embed code, download as MP4

Moodle Discussion Forum Submissions

Students add a new topic to submit presentations and follow same methods as in an assignment

Key difference: as presentations are submitted, they are listed for all users to see and access to view and/or make comments on

When student click to open a presentation, they will be able to view it:

- 1 through the link or
- 2 if it has been embedded by directly clicking on video
- 3 In this case, the video was not downloaded as an MP4, so that option is not shown, but is available in forum also

Students also have the option to Reply/ make a comment on other presenters work

NUR5309 has a Shared folder that each of you have access to

Once your group recording has been finalized, drag and drop recording into the NUR5309 Shared folder so that classmates and instructors will be able to view presentations

In your assignment, you may also submit your presentation using one of the 3 options shown to the right dependent upon your instructors requests:

1. copy URL link
2. embed video
3. create MP4 file

Explore the Product

1. Option 1: right click on the video to copy the URL code and paste it into the message box. You must then click on the hyperlink icon (double diagonal circle) in the tool bar and past the link into the URL, so that it will open the video from the URL link

2. Option 2: Right click on video and copy embed code, click on the ~~dropdown~~ arrow, click on the HTML code icon (<+>) paste the embed code, click HTML link again and video should show directly in forum post

3. Option 3: Shown as an attachment. Open video in editing screen, below video on right there is a less than symbol and a globe, as well as other options, and (...). Click on the (...) and select Download. This will download as an MP4 file. The MP4 file can be dragged and dropped into the Files box when creating a new forum post.
