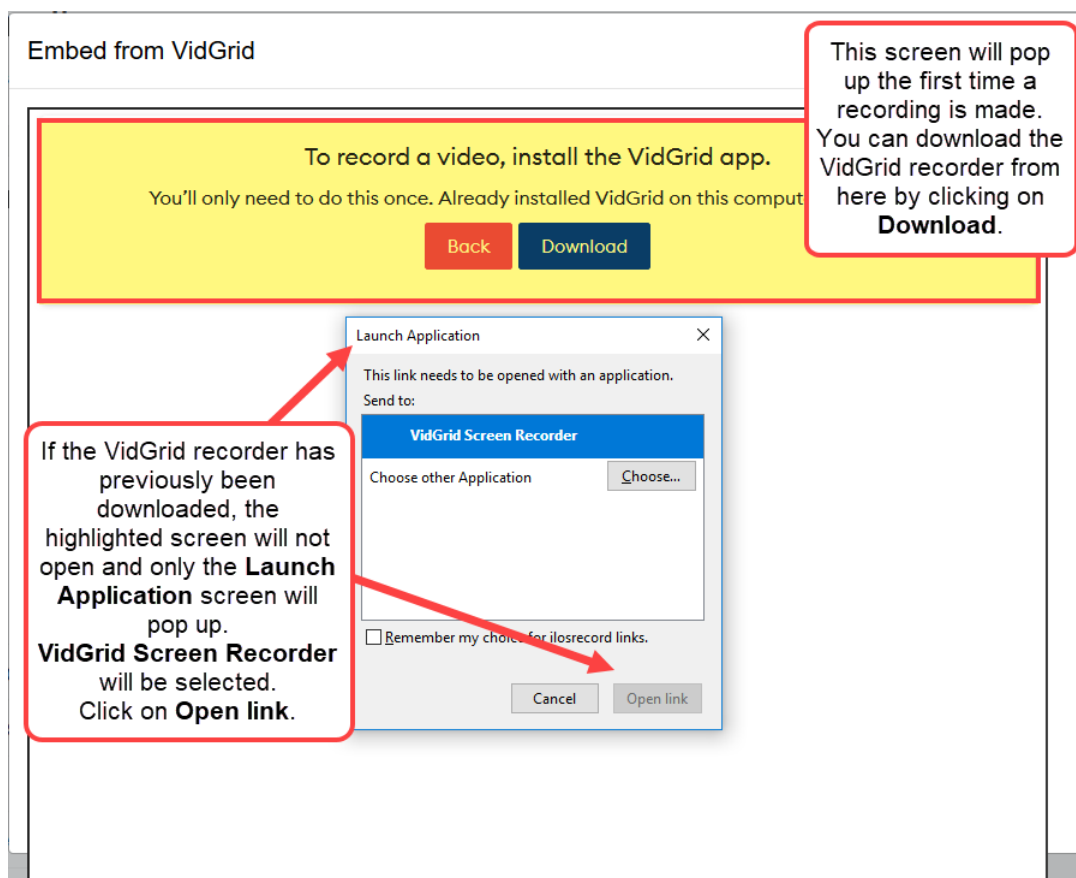
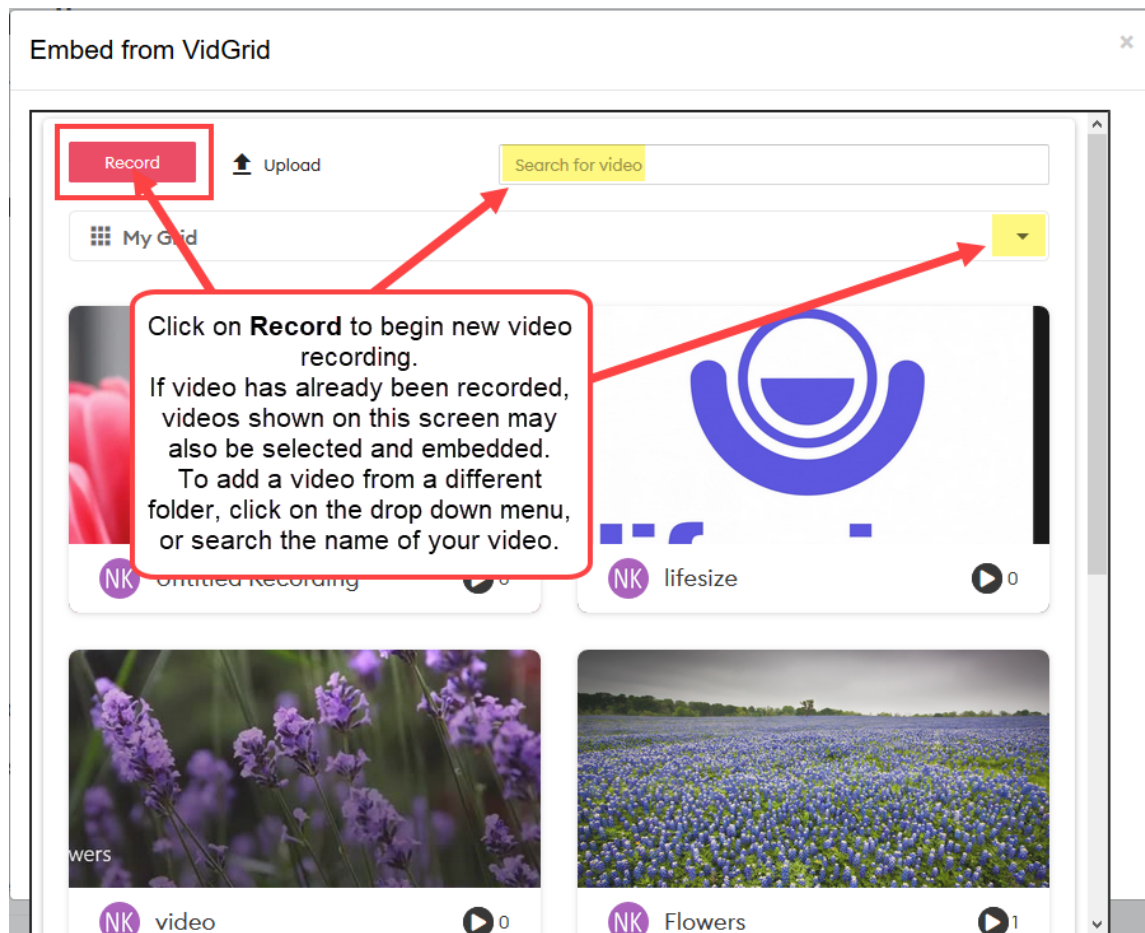

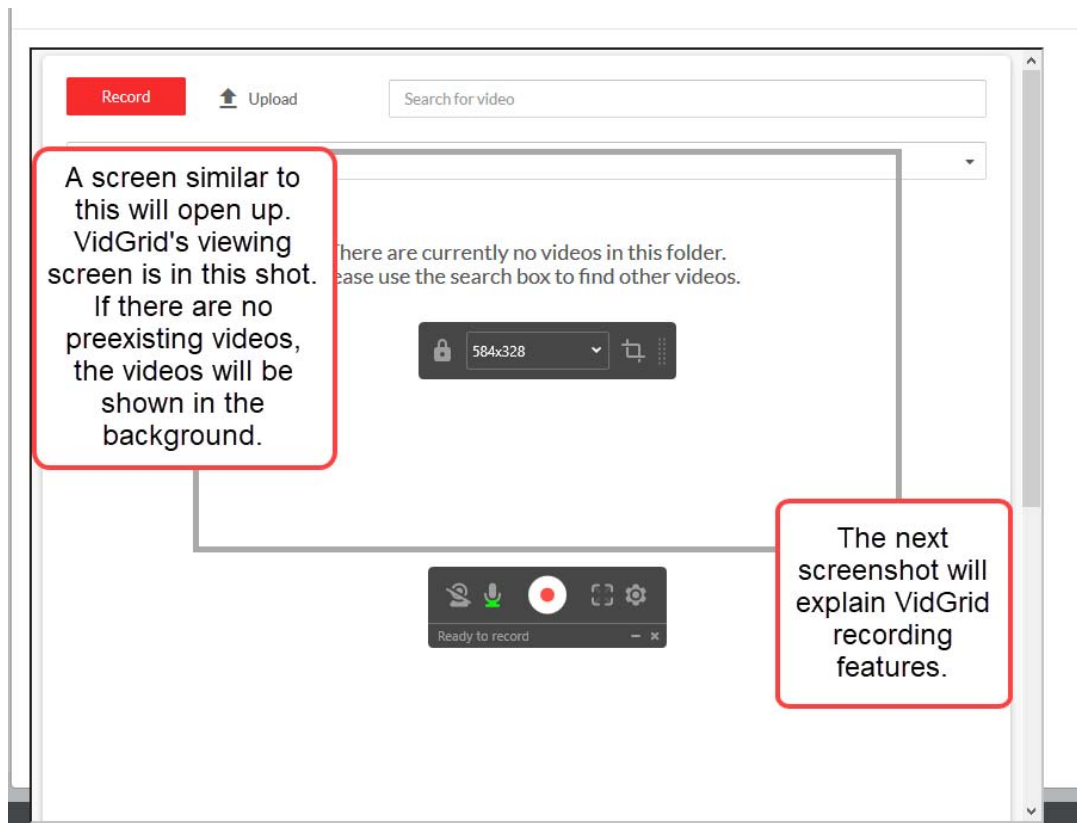

This gray box is movable and allows you to frame the selection that you would like to record.

The recorder block:

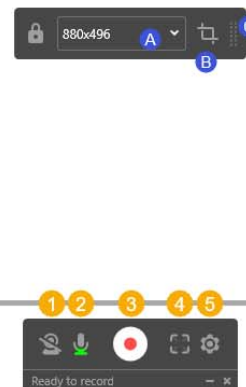
- 1 Select camera/webcam, or none (selecting none allows you to record your screen and nothing else).
- 2 Select microphone if external, mute/unmute, monitor sound (this will be green if it is picking up sound).
- 3 Record/stop recording
- 4 Full screen
- 5 Settings: adjust particular settings, such as countdown feature.

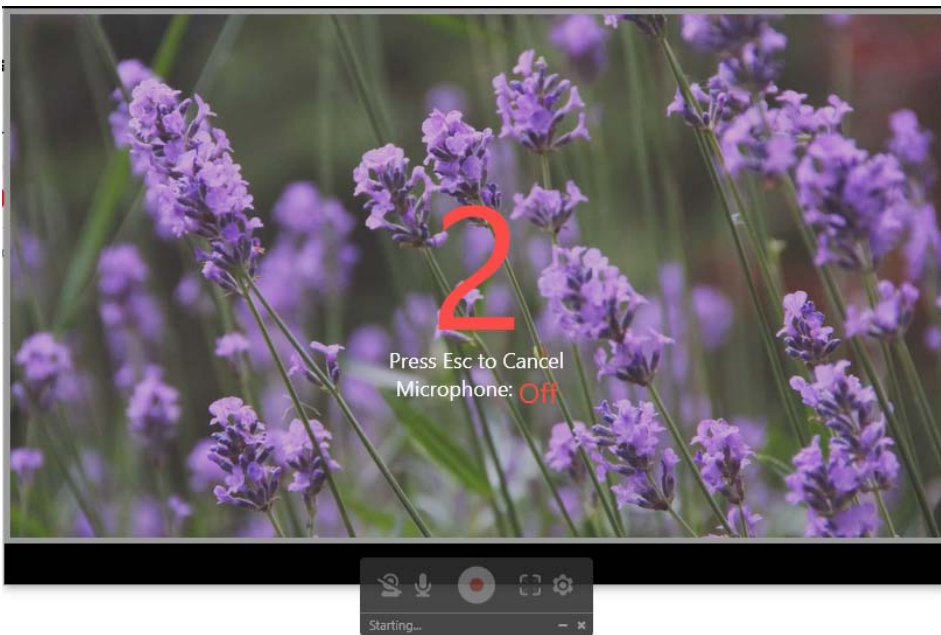
Optional features for Recording Box:

This box allows you to:

- A full screen,
- B customize dimensions, or
- C drag entire box around on the screen

If choosing a prerecorded video on the web or downloaded to computer, simply open a window, locate and open the video, frame it with the gray VidGrid Recording box and begin recording.





The gray box has been moved to frame the area to be recorded.

You will see a 3...2...1... countdown on the screen to indicate when to click play on the video that they are recording.

If you are recording yourself via webcam, you would click on the camera in the Recording Block and choose Webcam, frame yourself, and begin recording.

If audio is not present in recording, check your microphone settings.

When recording is stopped, the options to Title (1), Delete (2), or Check (3) if satisfied with recording are available.

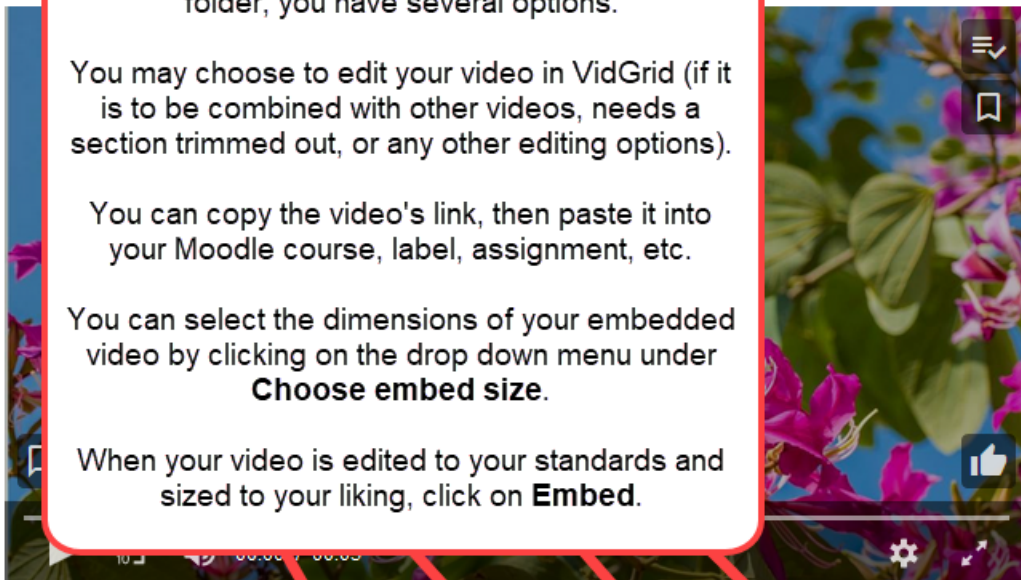
After your video is recorded or selected from a folder, you have several options.

You may choose to edit your video in VidGrid (if it is to be combined with other videos, needs a section trimmed out, or any other editing options).

You can copy the video's link, then paste it into your Moodle course, label, assignment, etc.

You can select the dimensions of your embedded video by clicking on the drop down menu under **Choose embed size**.

When your video is edited to your standards and sized to your liking, click on **Embed**.


